Group A training is for everyone. Everyone needs to have a basic level of awareness of safeguarding and how to report a concern – there is a Group A eLearning, however, we offer delivery face to face in a 2.5 hour session if preferred to eLearning. Group A training is a prerequisite to Group B.

Group B is for anybody in a front-line role. They should have a higher knowledge of safeguarding, know who to talk to if they notice something is wrong and how to report a concern. This is a 1 day session.

Our training offers a comprehensive course that is based on the Social Care Framework developed by Social Care Wales. This course provides a standardised approach to Safeguarding Adults and Children awareness training and includes the new All Wales Safeguarding procedures.
