This course raises awareness of the complex nature of domestic abuse and develops an understanding of the cycle of abuse. It increases the learners' knowledge of how abusive relationships can affect children and children's roles and behaviours. We aim to develop your understanding of manipulation and collusion of domestic abuse, and their effects on children.

Course aims

- Will have knowledge of the link between violence against women, domestic abuse and sexual violence and the risk to children
- Will be able to consider risks faced by the victim, posed by the perpetrator and experienced by children; and take appropriate actions to minimise these risks.
- Understand how to respond to the trauma of experiencing domestic abuse as a child.
- Be aware of resources for supporting children who have experienced domestic abuse.
